Isolation or lack of food in the supermarkets will not automatically entitle a client to a voucher. They should be directed to community self help groups etc.

A client will still need to be referred by an agency but if it is physically impossible to give the client a voucher, please could you ring the Coordinator with the details of the client, including a contact telephone number, and the number of the voucher being issued. The voucher can either be sent via an email attachment to info@waterside.foodbank.org.uk or through the post. If this too is impossible, informing the coordinator of the voucher number will be sufficient.
